Dear Parents/Carers,

So soon the summer is coming to an end, the Olympic and Paralympic games have kept us entertained and the Autumn Term has begun in fine style. It is my time once again to send out reminders for many different things:

- School dinners are still £2.10. It would be helpful if monies were paid in at the beginning of the week but we can accept daily orders if necessary. The current menu will still apply until October half term. If you think you might be entitled to a free school meal, ask at the office.

Musical instrument lessons have begun. Guitar lessons (electric and acoustic) are on Mondays, piano and recorder lessons start on Tuesday, 11th Sept., and violin lessons are on Fridays. If you would like your child to learn to play any instrument, please let Mrs. Moyse know and she will be able to give you further details.

The swimming pool is still closed so there will be no swimming until later this term. However, Mr. Ward will be taking the Grebes class for an extra p.e. lesson until the pool opens. Please make sure your child has their p.e. kit in school on Wednesday mornings.

Clubs - The breakfast and after-school clubs are running as per usual and your child can be cared for from 7.45 am to 6 pm almost all year round now. Childcare is also offered from lunchtime to the end of the school day (and later if necessary) for 3 year olds and over.
