Literacy/English:

- Daily phonics Focusing on letter formation, high frequency/ common exception/ tricky words.
- Year 1 will spend time focusing on nonsense and real words in preparation for the phonics screening test in May.
 - We will be focusing on different books which will link to our topic:
 - Whatever Next
 - Meerkat Mail
 - Amazing Grace
 - Grace and Family
 - Lila and the secret of rain

Expressive Art and Design:

- Draw maps of the local area.
- Draw pictures of significant features in Salhouse.
- Use a range of materials to express themselves.
- Use boxes and junk modelling to create rockets.
 - Make a solar system using papier Mache.
 - Make paper aeroplanes and carry out experiments on the fast aeroplanes.

Physical Development:

• The children will have PE once a week on a Wednesday with Mr Ward.

Communication and Language:

- Role plays areas will be a time machine, travel agent and airport during this term focusing on real life situations (Understanding the world).
 - Children will be encouraged to use past, present and future forms accurately when talking about events that have happened or are to happen in the future.
 - We will have weekly circle times linking to Personal, social and emotional areas of development.

At home, we expect your children to read three times. Year One children have access to activelearn where I will be setting weekly maths activities for your child to do at home.
