On Monday 3rd July all schools within our cluster are coming together to bring a shared and important message to our children. All children from year 1 to Year 4 will participate in an online safety workshop led by ESTE Trainers, rated by Ofsted as Outstanding.

The children will have workshops in year groups or Key Stages and all sessions will be held at Rackheath Primary School to ensure as many pupils as possible can participate. We have organised transport to and from Rackheath Primary School for all our pupils.

The workshops will encourage children to think about how they behave online and what apps they are using. It will highlight what is safe and what is not and how to improve their safety online. As a Cluster we feel this is a very prominent and urgent issue and that it is essential our young people are as equipped as possible to stay safe.
