- Investigate conductors/ insulators /wire length.

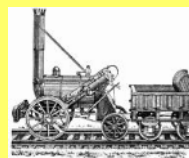
Mechanical Forces

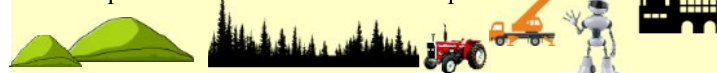
