Amazona Zoo Trip – 11th June 2018

On Monday June 11th the Coots, Bitterns, Grebes and Herons who are not at Holt Hall will be going to visit Amazona Zoo in Cromer. This will link in brilliantly with our current rainforest theme!

Amazona is one of the county's most unique and fun days out where we will discover South American wildlife. The zoo is home to over 200 tropical animals including jaguars, monkeys, snakes, flamingos and tapirs. It is committed to helping visitors discover nature and provide education on conservation issues.

Highlights include a Feline Forest with ocelot, pumas and jaguar; a tropical house with spectacled caiman, anaconda snake and iguanas, as well as, Chilean flamingos and South American wildfowl. In addition, we will discover Amazon parrots, macaws, squirrel monkeys, red-legged seriema and Geoffroy's spider monkeys.
