The Norfolk Music Service

The Norfolk Music Hub

Norfolk Music Hub is a partnership of every organisation and school which engages with Norfolk's children and young people in music making. These organisations share what they do, communicate with each other and are committed to the highest quality of music education for children & young people.

The hub is funded by the Department of Education which is administered by Arts Council England to create more opportunities for children and young people to get involved in music. Music Hubs are already working with 80% of schools in England, meaning that around one million children and young people are learning a musical instrument.
