Message in a **Bottle Found** after 50 Years!

What is a message in a bottle?

- A message in a bottle is a note or letter which has been sealed in a waterproof bottle.
- They have usually been dropped into the sea although many break apart and aren't found again.

A nine-year-old boy has found a message in a bottle 50 years after it was dropped over the side of a ship! He's also managed to track down the person who dropped it way back in 1969.

Jyah Elliott was fishing with his dad on Talia Beach in South Australia when they came across a rather unusual find.

Hidden in the dunes was a rather old-looking glass bottle with some paper in it. When they broke it open, they found there was a written message inside!

They saw that it came from a 13-year-old boy called Paul Gilmore. He was travelling on an ocean liner with his family from Britain to live in Australia.

The message describes his journey and the ship he sailed on. The date at the top of the letter read 17th November 1969. That's 50 years ago!

The letter said that he was 1000 miles away from Fremantle in Western Australia when he sent the letter.

It also told whoever found the letter to reply and even gave an address so they could send him a letter.

When Jyah found the letter, he was very excited. His family shared a picture of the bottle and managed to find the letter's author. Paul Gilmore is now 63 years old.

According to his family, Paul doesn't know that his letter's been found as he's on holiday on a cruise ship.



"He'll be chuffed to bits," Paul's sister said. This letter isn't the oldest message in a bottle! Last year, a woman in Western Australia found a bottle with a letter which was 132 years old!

People have been sending messages in bottles through the sea for thousands of years. The ancient Greeks used them to explore how water flowed into the Mediterranean Sea.

However, as plastic pollution has become a real problem for our oceans, many think it's time to stop this practice or switch to biodegradable alternatives.

dunes A mound of sand formed by

the wind, often by the sea.

ocean liner A large ship used to take

people on long journeys.

pollution The presence of harmful things in an environment,

such as plastic.

biodegradable Able to easily be broken down

by bacteria.
