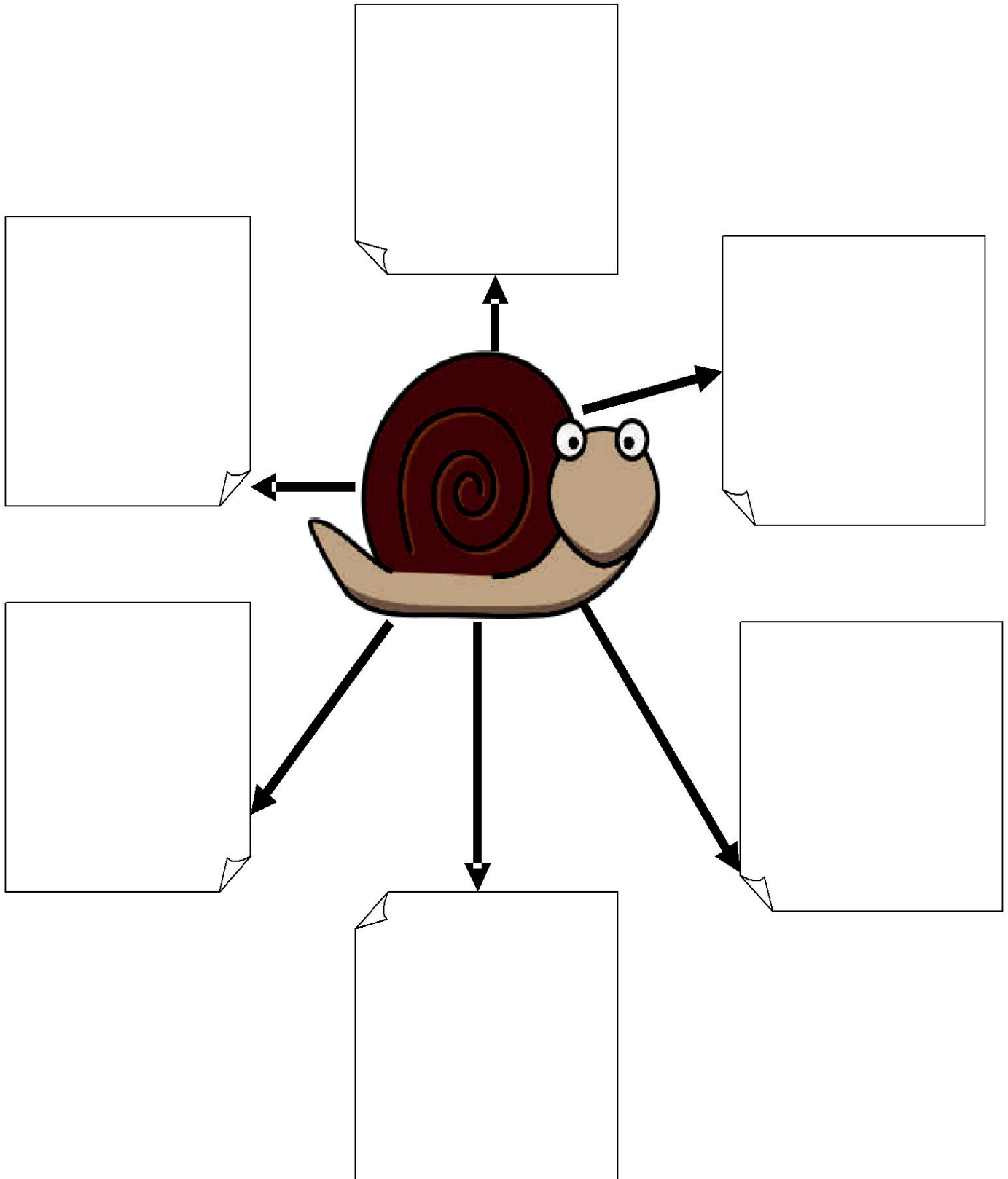


What is the snail like?

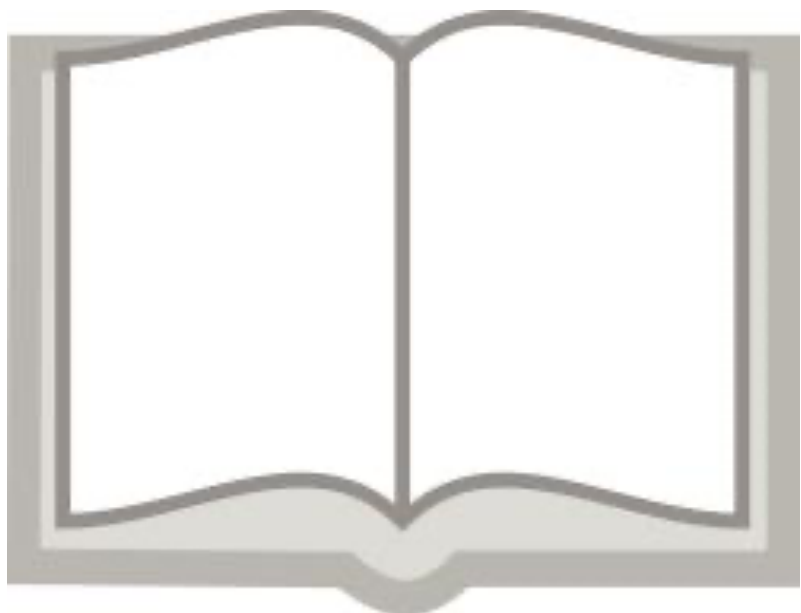

What are the problems with snail's rescue idea?

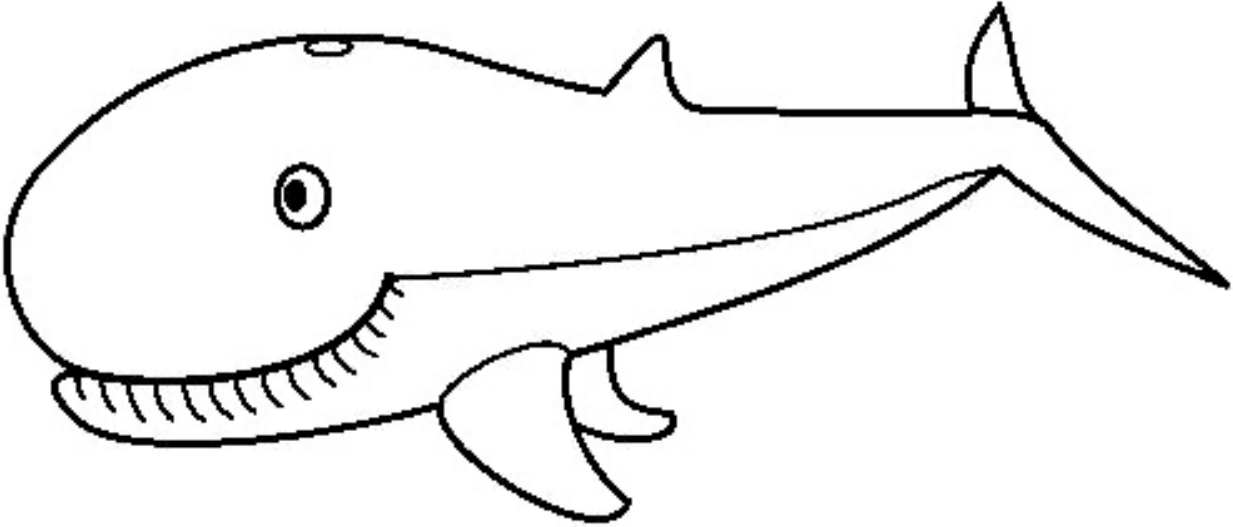
Snail goes into a school and writes a message on the blackboard.
