As scientists, we will observe and discuss seasons, describe weather associated with each season. We will find out what plants need to grow/how do they grow in different climates?

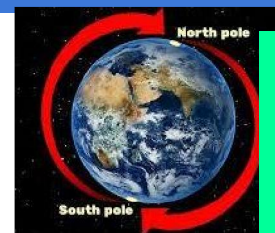
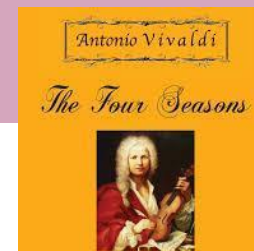
We will enjoy a Science week. - more information on this will follow.
