Herons' trip on Monday October 4th

To link in with our learning about the history of the Norfolk Broads and the geography of our local area, along with the design/science aspect of how wind pumps work, Our class will be travelling to the Wind Energy museum in Repps on Monday 4th October. We will travel by coach and spend the morning at the museum, learning about how the Broads were drained and the evolution of the wind pump. We will then walk along the river Thurne, observing the landscape and wildlife to reach Thurne Mill which will be open and operating especially for us (wind power required though, of course!). This trip will take place during normal school hours as we aim to be back by 3 pm.

The cost of the trip is £10.00 per child to cover the cost of the coach and entrance to the museum.
