Home learning:

It would be great if all Coots would continue to read their reading books as well as to enjoy stories at home. Please send in the reading folder every Tuesday, so we can share progress and change their book. Please continue to use Active Learn/Book Bug, as it is a super reading resource, as well as our virtual school library. Doodle Maths proved popular during lockdown, so you might like to use this, too. To support the children's phonics, we will continue to tell you on Tapestry the sounds we have been learning, so you can work on reading and writing these at home.

Coots authors will focus on learning to read and write the phonic phase 2, 3 and 4 sounds and blends. We will continue working on the correct pencil grip, and forming letters, using the cursive style. We will begin to write our surnames.

As readers, we will continue to blend sounds to read, and we will learn the phase 2, 3 and 4 tricky/red words, and blends, like br, st, etc

Coots artists will find out about the colour wheel, and explore colour mixing.

As scientists we will learn about the best materials for different uses, such as dens and rafts, floating and sinking. We will investigate how shadows move across a day.

In RE, Coots will think about, 'What difference does Prayer make to the lives of Christians and Muslims?' We will learn about the Good Samaritan.



As philosophers, we will develop our thinking, listening, discussion and reasoning skills, including, in RSHE, that there are no such things as good or bad feelings. We will also explore important relationships and that not all families are the same.

As mathematicians we will count to 100. We will begin to read and write calculations including adds and subtractions. We will count in 2s, 5s, and 10s, and learn about odd and even numbers. We will read and write numbers to 20.



Coots geographers will learn about maps and compare our local area to different localities. We will look at how human behaviour is impacting upon oceans.

As musicians we will sing Sea Shanties and Pirate songs, thinking about the rhythm and repetition. We will listen to soundtracks from Pirate movies, and appraise them.

Coots athletes will continue to develop control, balance and coordination, joining in individually or as a partner or playing games as a team member. PE is still on Tuesdays, so come to school in your PE kit and trainers.
