## **Home learning:**

It would be wonderful if all Coots share stories, and enjoy books together, at home. Coots authors will focus on learning to read and write the phonic phase 2 sounds. We will continue working on the correct pencil grip, and forming the letter shapes, using the cursive style. We will learn to write our names, too.
