My School Fund

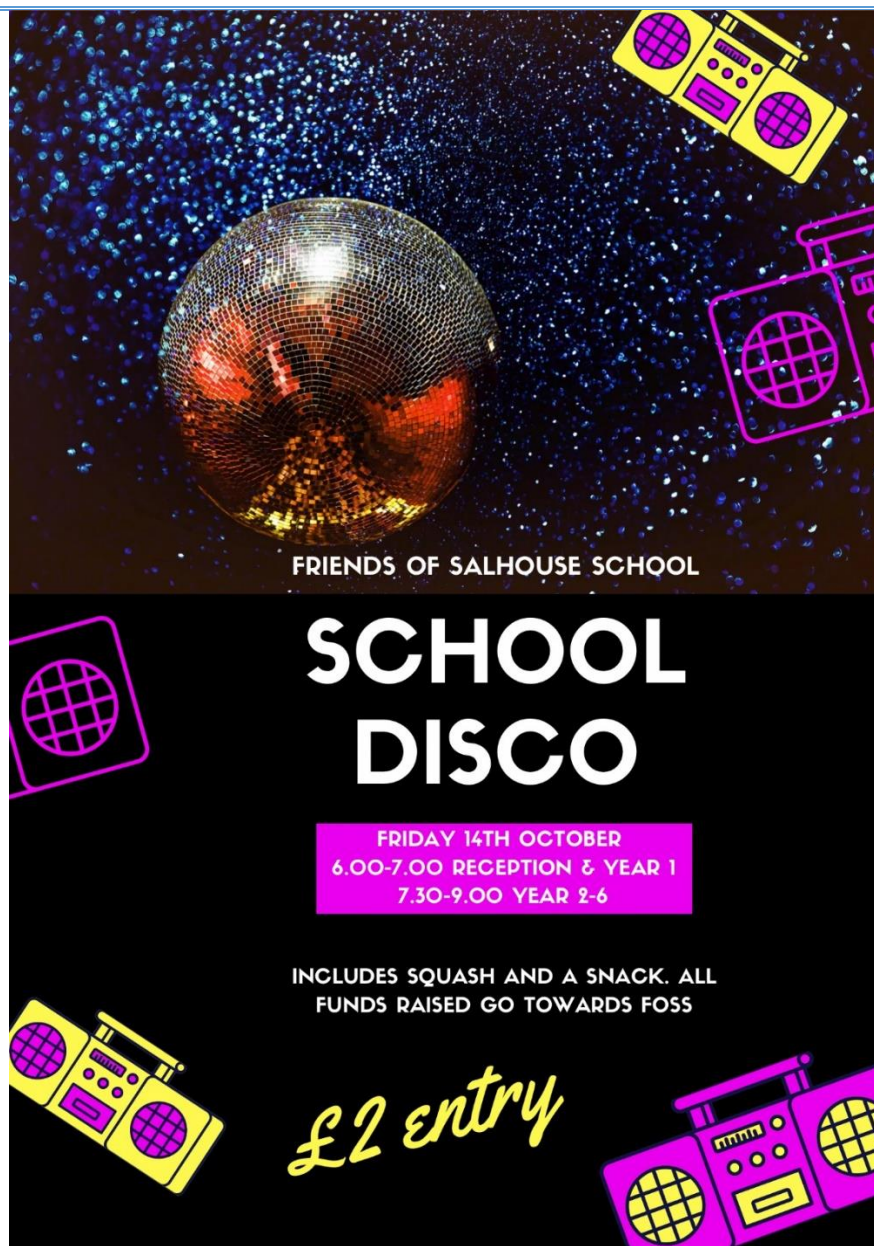
Our 'My School Fund' currently stands at £51.56. We would really like to get to £100 before Christmas.
