TERRIBLE happened.

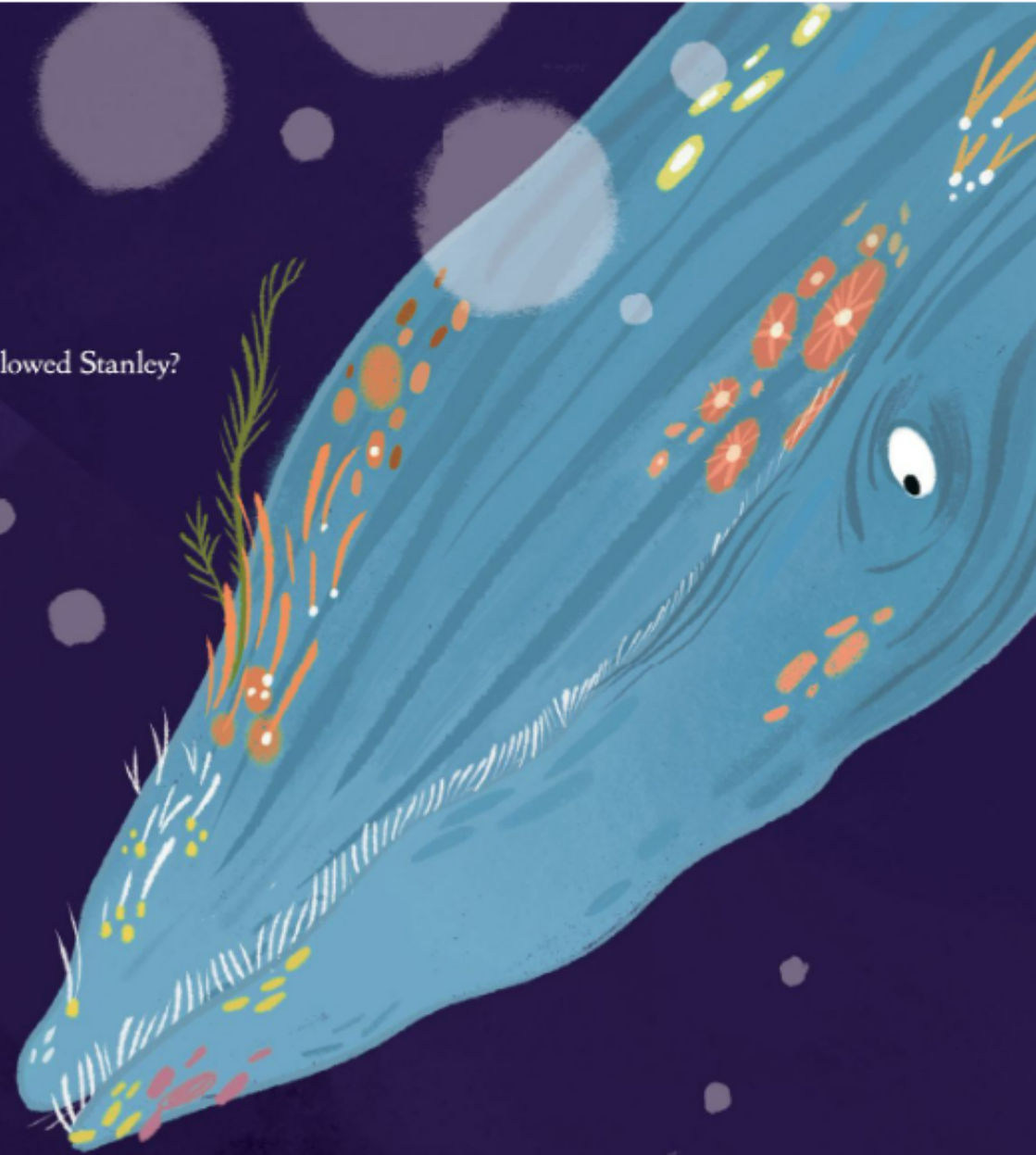



Somebody

and then...

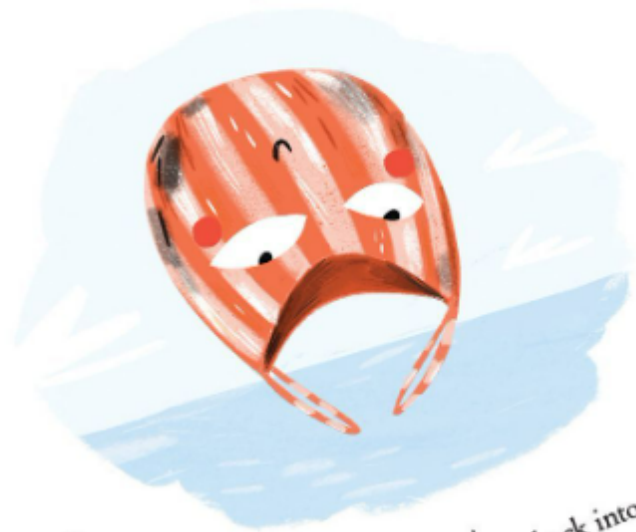


WHOOOOOOOSSSS

swallowed Stanley?

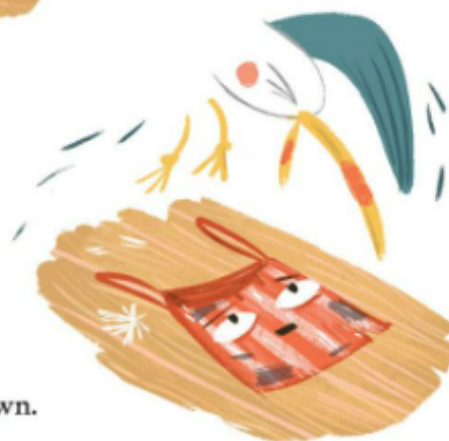


He

Her paddle-shaped flippers skimmed the seabed.

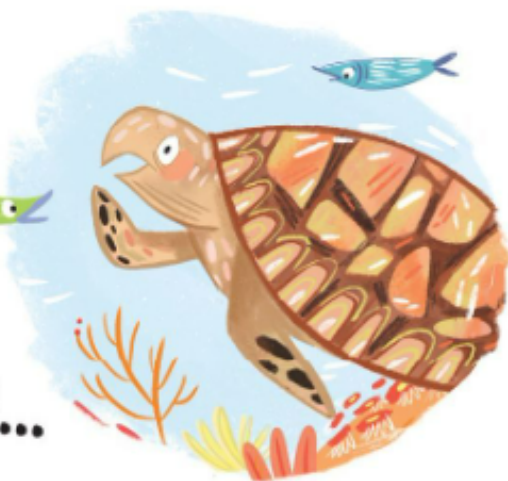
She had a beautiful shell and a small wrinkly head.

So **WHO** had swallowed Stanley?




She

But Stanley was stuck without much he could do!

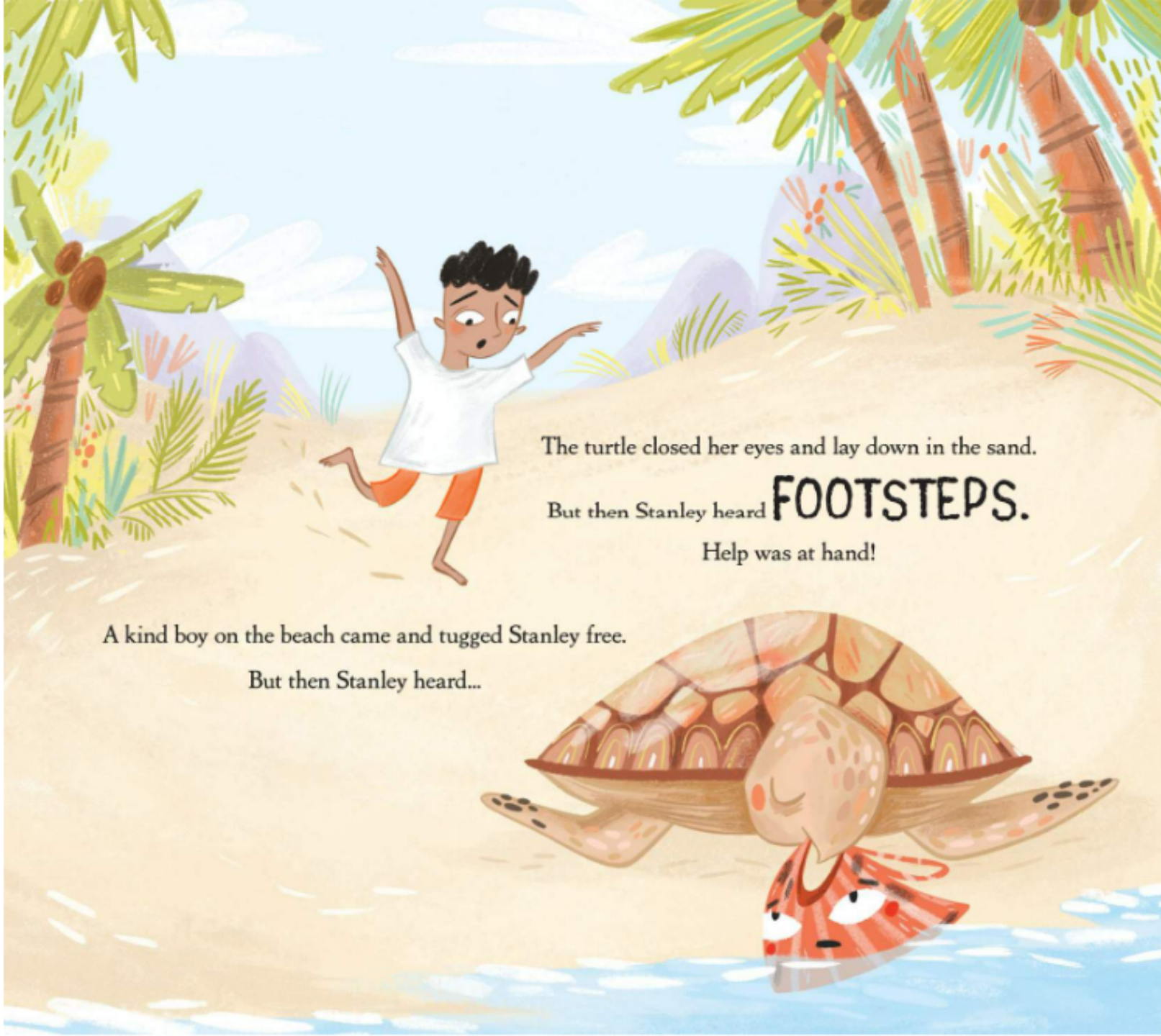


A **TURTLE** had swallowed Stanley!
