On Wednesday 14th December our Key Stage 2 children will be at Salhouse Baptist Chapel performing Christmas Carols, songs and readings.

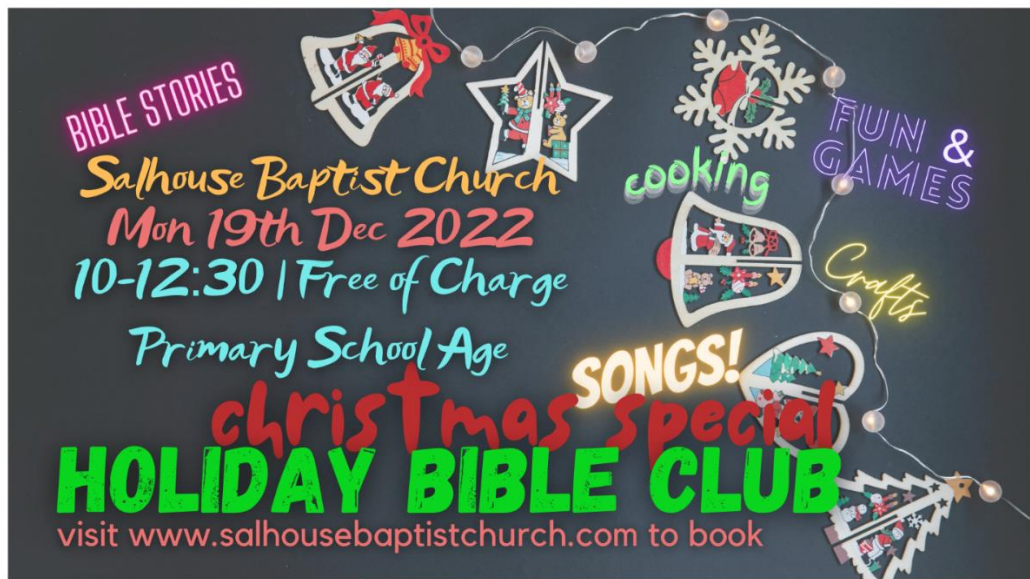
