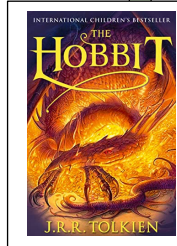


Vikings – linked to Vikings & Dragons

- Four Operations – formal written methods

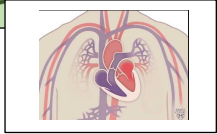

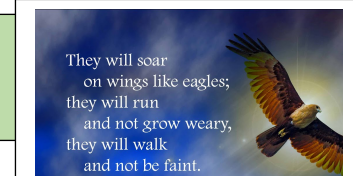
