Dance Lessons

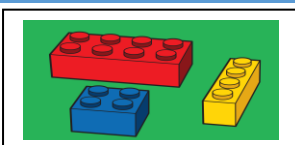
We are looking to start dance lessons in the summer term, numbers dependent.

If you are interested please let the school office know.

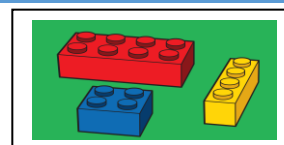
Attendance
