<b>Context</b>	We are a singing school (we haven't always been). Every Tuesday, we sing! Worship through <b>song and music</b> is now a big part of our school culture. It brings us together, lifts our hearts and our spirits.

Wednesday	
<b>Context</b>	Exploring <b>current affairs</b> is a challenging aspect of our wider curriculum which focuses on personal and character development. Through exploring current affairs, our children adopt a global perspective growing individuals who go on to have a positive impact on the people and the world around them.

<b>Supported by</b>	Teaching colleagues
<b>Attended by</b>	Class based collective worship to ensure age appropriate exposure to current affairs.

Thursday	
<b>Context</b>	Collective worship <b>planned and delivered by the children</b> increases pupil engagement, strengthens relationships and grows our teaching and learning community. Pupils are given a strong voice to explore their faith, worldview and take social action.
<b>Led by</b>	Pupils
<b>Supported by</b>	Teachers / House and Deputy House Captains / Pupils leading social action at school
<b>Attended by</b>	Varies (whole school, individual classes, key stage, Houses)

Friday	
<b>Context</b>	It is important to our community that we generously <b>celebrate</b> our own and other's lives and achievements. It is a driver behind building individual and community esteem, confidence, motivation, courage and resilience to take a full and fulfilling role in life.
<b>Led by</b>	Teachers
<b>Supported by</b>	Colleagues
<b>Attended by</b>	Varies: Class, key stage, whole school. Parents are invited.

<b>Greeting</b>	<b>Worship Lead :</b> Peace be with you <b>All:</b> And also with you
<b>Prayer</b>	Worship Lead or a pupil chosen by Worship Lead
<b>Lord's Prayer</b>	Worship Lead selects a younger child to support them in leading the prayer
<b>Blessing</b>	<b>Worship Lead:</b> Let love and peace be with you <b>All:</b> And also with you.

<b>Harvest</b>	Celebrated at All Saints Anglican Church, Salhouse
<b>Christmas</b>	Celebrated at school
<b>Christingle</b>	Celebrated at school in partnership with All Saints Anglican Church, Salhouse
