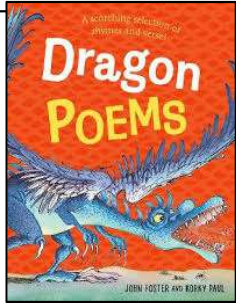
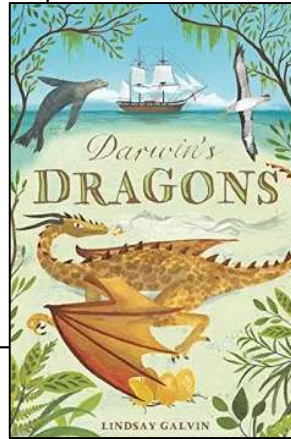


Grebes Parent Plan Spring 2023
