Year one scientists will distinguish between objects and materials whilst describing their properties.

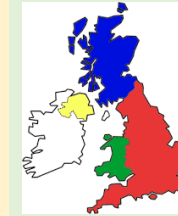

Our **EYFS explorers** will compare life in the UK to other continents. Our **year 1 explorers** will name and locate the 4 countries of the UK using atlases and globes. They will use geographical vocabulary to refer to physical and human features.

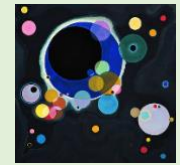


In **Computing**, we will learn about age related e-safety, explore uses of technology with a focus on Doodle maths.
