Our big questions this term are:

History


Children will develop their understanding of chronology, build relevant vocabulary and explore the way of life of the Stone and Iron Age periods. They will learn how we know about life so long ago and create reports and art work linked to their learning.



Geography

Building on their previous learning on the continents, Kingfishers will find and mark countries on a map of the world, beginning with places relevant to them. They will use the internet and reference books to explore physical and human features - particularly ones that can be seen from space!

They will develop their map making and reading skills.



Art

Kingfishers will be exploring the artists Wassil Kandinsky and Georgia O'Keefe. We will begin our expressive journey by exploring the paintings Several Circles and Starlight Night.

Children will use shapes, colours and textures to create their own painting and prints.


I.T

Kingfishers will learn how to stay safe whilst online and make posters to share what they have learnt.

They will learn how to effectively use search engines through research in History and Geography.



Science



We will be identifying sources of light, that it can be reflected from surfaces and that we need light in order to see things. Children will be creating their own investigations linked to shadows; how they are created and how they can be changed. Linked to our writing focus, they will write these investigations up using diagrams, headings and subheadings.

Music



Kingfishers will explore the question 'Does music bring us closer together?'

They will be playing instruments, improvising and composing.

They will be introduced to simple musical notation.

Songs they will be responding to include: 'Home is where the heart is' 'Hallelujah chorus' from Messiah, 'Let's work it out together' and 'The Loco-Motion'.

Children will be learning about the design process:

French
