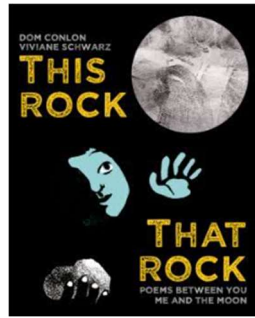
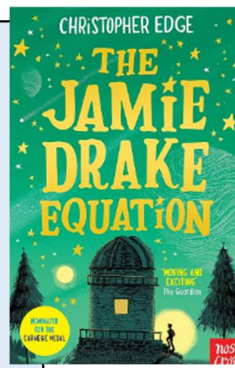


English

Science

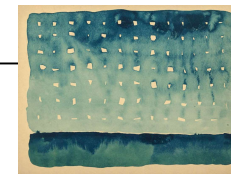
- **Space** - Learn about the celestial bodies in our Solar System and choose one to research in depth and make a digital presentation about.
