I liked the "hamster wheel" because one of the men walked around it. That was the best ever.

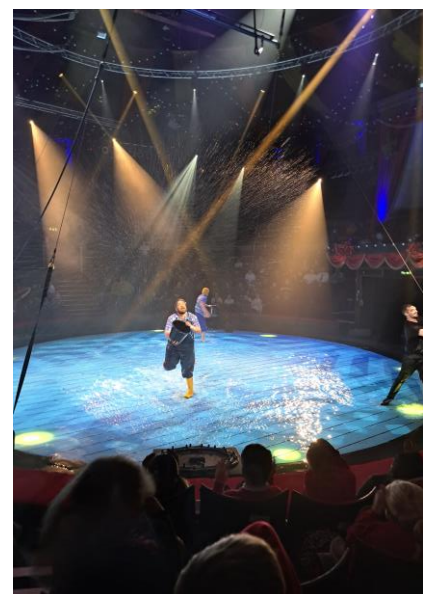
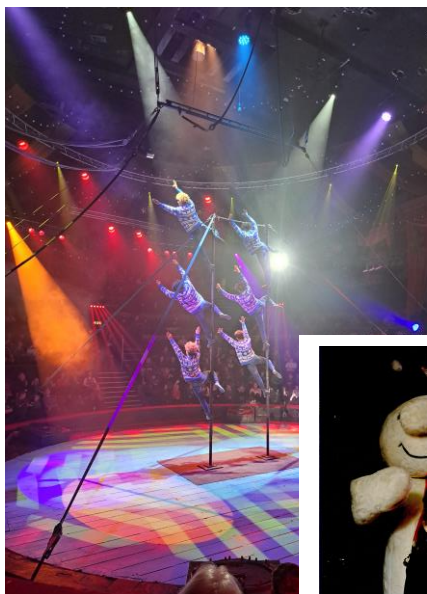
The other thing I liked is the swimmers because it was fun to watch.

Christmas Performances

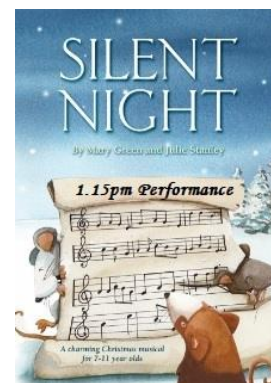
The Christmas Performance – Key stage 2

We had an amazing audience. We dressed up as villagers. There were 80 people watching us.

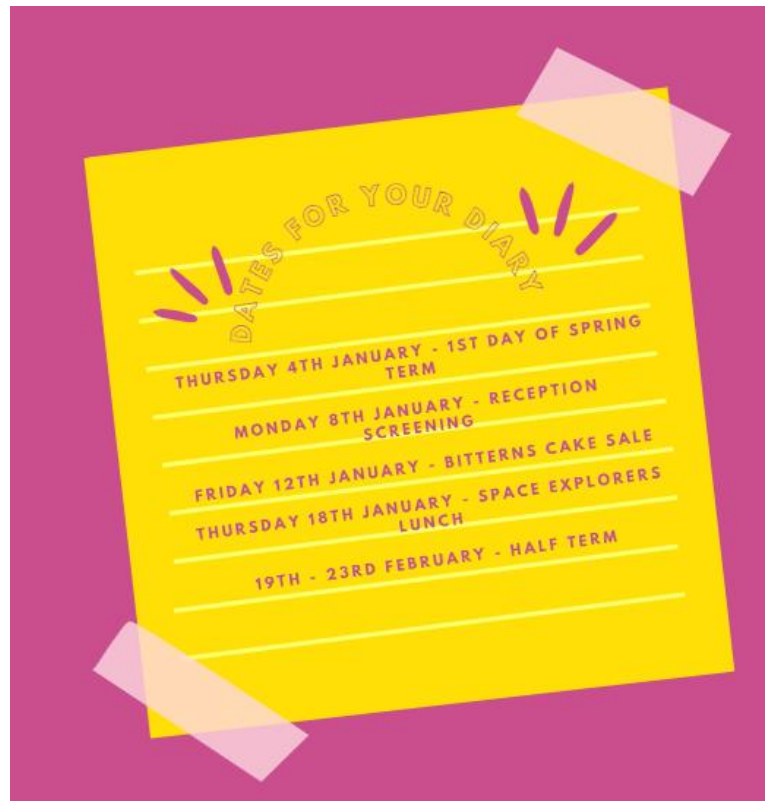
We sang “Guten Morgen” and “Alleluia Yodel”.
