
As mathematicians the year one children will be learning about addition and subtraction, mass and volume, place value and length and height. The year two children will continue to develop their mathematical understanding by learning about money, multiplication and division, length and height and mass, capacity and temperature. All the children will be following the White Rose scheme of work and a long-term plan can be found on the class page in the maths folder.

As geographers, we will be using globes, atlases and aerial photography to identify countries around the world. We will explore maps and the children will learn to use map symbols, creating their own maps and keys.

Within **RSHE** we will be learning about our bodies, our relationships, our beliefs and our rights and responsibilities

As artists and designers, we will paint and sculpt with focus on the natural world. We will ask questions such as 'what is sculpture?' 'What materials have they used?' and 'What makes this amazing?'





Wonders of the World

Within religious education, we will be learning about the Christian story of Easter. We will consider why Easter is an important time for Christians. We will be curious about what our senses tell us about the world of religion and faith.

The children will continue to have weekly spellings to learn and will have reading books coming home. Please support us by encouraging them to practice their reading and spellings daily.

Our Christian core values this term will be trust and perseverance.

Within literacy we will be exploring instructions, poetry, persuasive writing and creative writing. As readers we will read books such as the 'The Magic and Mystery of Trees', 'Dear Earth' and 'Stanley's Stick'. As writers we will develop our ability to write independently, use punctuation and write using a cursive style of handwriting. We will be writing instructions and non-chronological reports. Our phonics' learning will support our ability to decode new words when reading and writing. We will continue to follow the Jolly Phonics scheme of learning.

As historians we will be learning about toys in the past. We will consider how toys have changed throughout history comparing the past with the present.



In PE we will be learning about gymnastics with Mr Ward.

Within computing we will be developing our digital literacy by learning how to create, store, and retrieve digital content. We will explore the uses of technology in the modern world.

As musicians, we will be following the Charascheme. This term we will listen, appreciate music, and create our own compositions. We will also invent a musical story.
