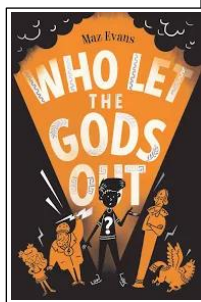

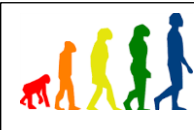
Science

- Draw, paint and sculpt with focus on recycled materials & famous artists.

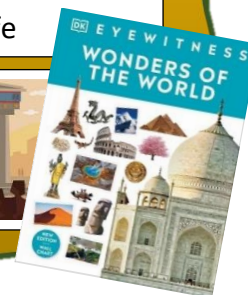
