### **Parking**


Please can we remind you to be considerate of our neighbours during school drop off and pick up. Do not block driveways or park within 10 metres of a junction.



Salhouse are planning a World Book Week beginning March 4th!




On Monday 4<sup>th</sup> March, you may dress up as your favourite character if you wish, it would be lovely if you were able to bring in a book linked to this character on the day.




