Year 5 and 6 Forest School

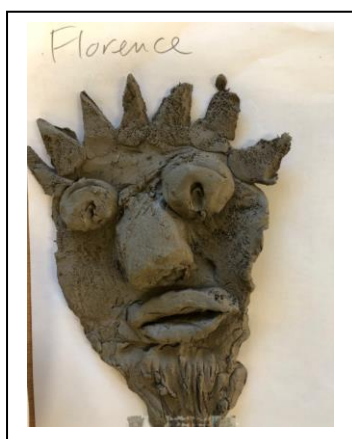
What goes on at Forest School?

Forest School students learn through immersive play and activities that they can choose to do in the wooded area of the school.

As well as planned activities each week the students can also choose to climb trees to a set height and create animal habitats, care for the forest area, learn about fire, cook seasonal recipes, making structures from wood, learn about animal species and habitats, learn to use tools safely and knots are learnt.

The students conclude their sessions by reflecting on their Forest School experiences by sharing their magic moments and sometimes listening to a story, song, poem or sounds of nature around the campfire.
