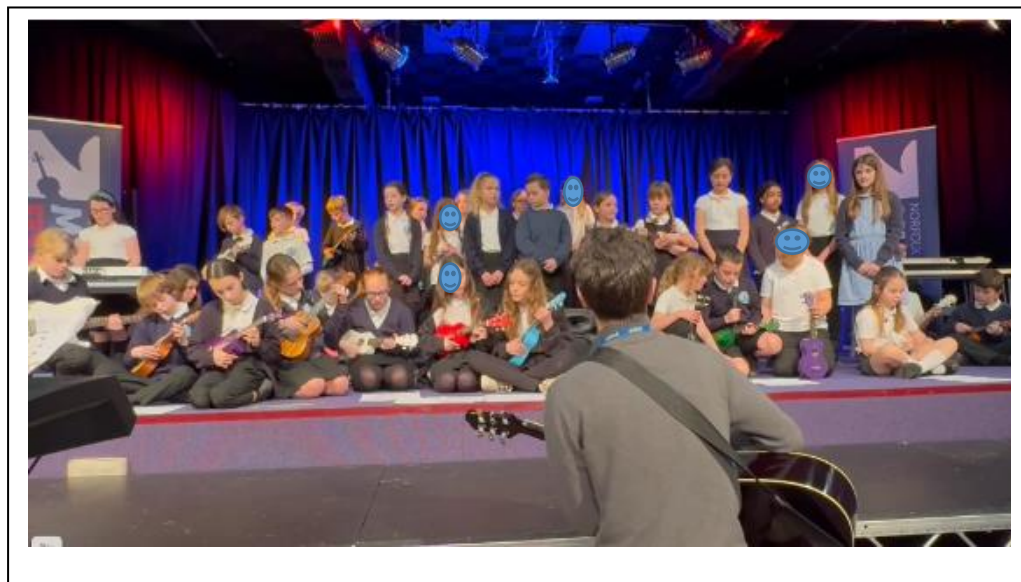
Norfolk Music Festival

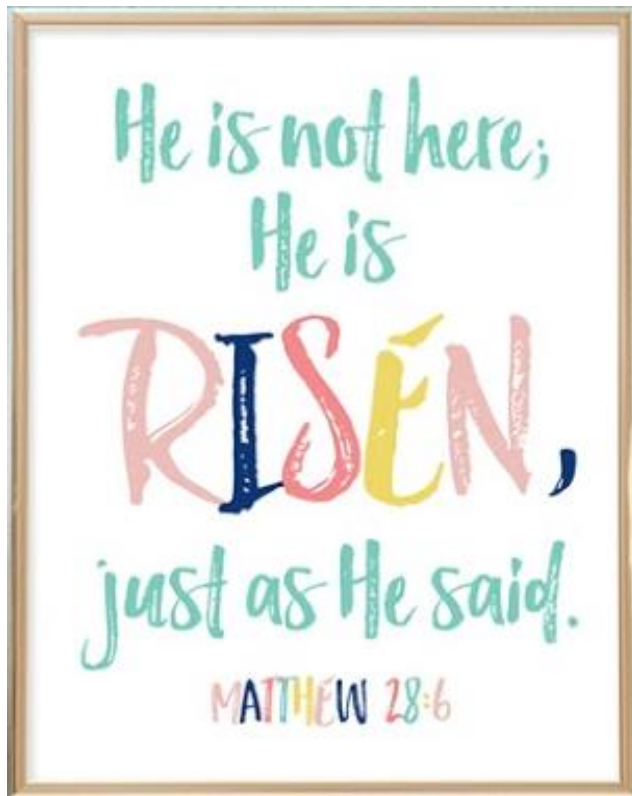
