Our scientists will develop their working scientifically skills whilst learning about space, forces, and materials. Key areas and vocabulary will include states of matter, gases, liquids and solids, electromagnet, force, friction, magnet, magnetic material and magnetism.



Our musicians will create compositions in response to

animation. These will be in response to the theme: mountains. Key vocabulary will include: melodies, compose, notate, soundscape and rhythm.

In RSHE, children will learn about families, relationships, health and wellbeing. This will include yoga, stretching and building resilience.

Our linguists will be learning to read, write, listen and speak about what life is like in French classrooms.

Our **explorers** will investigate and locate 3 contrasting regions around the world. *Geographical skills*: locational knowledge, place knowledge, human and physical geography and geographical skills and fieldwork.

In class, we will share books daily. Our writing roots from Literacy Tree will be 'Leon and the place in between' and 'The Tin Forest'. Our class reading book will be 'The



Our big question we will explore during the autumn term:
